Our Grades 2 – 8 Fidelity House Day Camp will now hold many of our summer camp activities at Regis College in Weston from June 24 – August 16 (We start and end the day at Fidelity House). Activities include daily Red Cross swimming lessons, sports, arts & crafts, archery, age appropriate group activities, nature activities, free swim time, gymnastics, all camp field trips & talent show performances. Single week registrations are accepted. Camp runs Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. with an option for extended care until 6:30 p.m. AFTER DAY CAMP, Fidelity House runs August Adventure Days from August 19 – August 30.
