

CAMP HOURS

Camp runs from **8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m**. with an **option** for up to two hours of extended care available (**until 6:30 p.m.**).

Children should be dropped off at the Fidelity House gym daily Monday through Friday, between 8 and 8:20 a.m. and picked up at 4:30 p.m. After 4:30, your child will be brought to the extended care area.

Camp. We are working to offer both Red Cross certified swim lessons taught by our Certified Pool Staff and recreational swims. Pool guidelines and availability will determine our aquatics schedule this year.

OUR STAFF

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Children should arrive at Fidelity House between 8:00A.M. and 8:20 A.M. daily.

- Please call Fidelity House by 8:25 A.M. any day your child will not be attending camp.
 - If for any reason you do not want your child involved in the swimming program for the day or for any period of time, please notify us.
- All articles of clothing, lunch boxes, towels, etc. should be labeled with child's name.
- Personal toys, cell phones, electronics & collector cards should remain at home.

This Camp complies with regulations of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health and is licensed by the local board of health.

REGISTRATION STEP BY STEP

NOTE- we are currently doing WAIT LIST registrations only.

At Initial Registration

Please fill out the one page registration form per child and leave a deposit. A \$75.00 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit per week (per child) is required to hold the spot.

It will be credited toward the camp fee and is not an additional fee. Receipt of the deposit is acceptance into the camp. To conserve our paper resources, we do not send out confirmation letters. Registration deadline for each week/session of camp is the preceding Friday at 5 p.m.. A \$20 late fee will be applied to registrations after 5:00 p.m.

Before Attendance at Camp



1). Payment is due. Any BALANCE DUE for the upcoming week/session must be paid the preceding Friday. We do not send out weekly bills, please do not wait for a bill to arrive before

rendering payment.

2). A <u>DOCTOR signed</u>/**MEDICAL** (Immunization) **RECORD is <u>mandatory</u>** and requested 1 WEEK before your child attends.

3). Department of Early Education and Care FORMS are <u>mandatory</u> and requested 1 WEEK before your child attends camp.

4). ALL MEDICATIONS (short term/long term) require a medication authorization on file. Please request the form if applicable.
